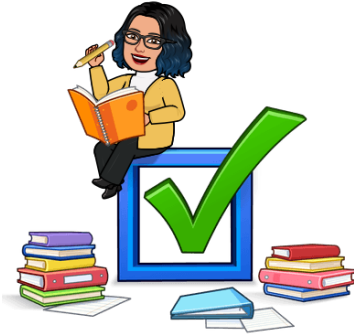
When we return from break we will continue to diligently read Wolf Hollow! Have a great much needed break!

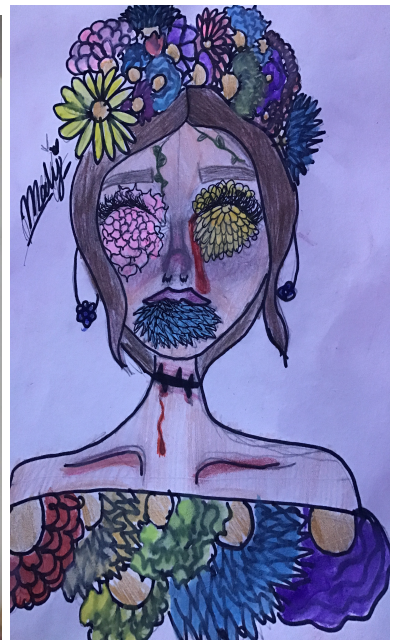
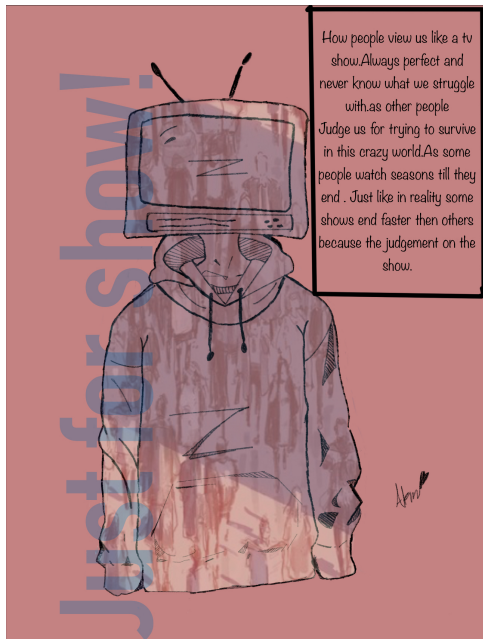
